
LITHUANIAN ECONOMY IN 2050 - CIRCULAR AND CLIMATE NEUTRAL



Government Programme has set the vision for public sector to become climate neutral, with green public procurement as a key instrument in transforming government operations. As of 2023, all public authorities are obliged to buy 100% green.



SUSTAINABLE BUILDINGS

THE LONG-TERM RENOVATION STRATEGY OF LITHUANIA AIMS TO TRANSFORM THE EXISTING BUILDING STOCK INTO ENERGY EFFICIENT, DECARBONIZED, AND IN LINE WITH THE PRINCIPLES OF UNIVERSAL DESIGN BY 2050

- As of 2021, new building constructions must meet the highest energy efficiency standard (A++)
- From November 2024, wood and organic materials will have to make up at least 50% of construction materials in newly built public buildings
- From 2025, new public buildings will have to be built following a chosen sustainable building scheme, such as BREEM, LEED, FITWEL, etc.

AS OF 2023, PUBLIC AUTHORITIES ARE OBLIGED TO BUY 100% ELECTRICITY FROM RENEWABLES



LOW-CARBON MOBILITY

BASED ON THE ALTERNATIVE FUELS ACT, WHICH CAME INTO FORCE IN 2021, THE PUBLIC AUTHORITIES MUST GRADUALLY SHIFT TOWARDS CLEAN VEHICLES*


